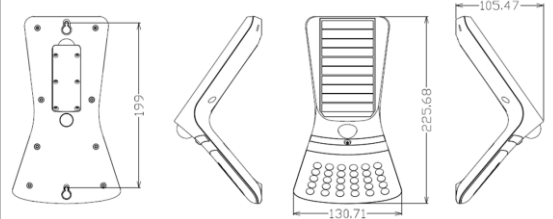

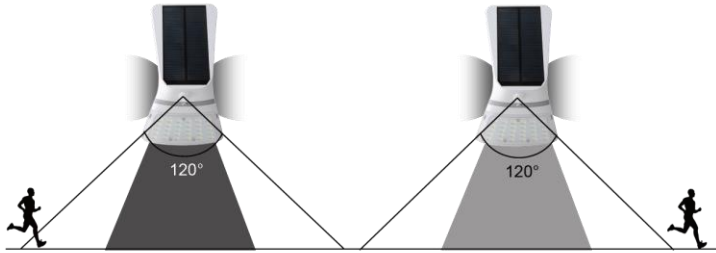

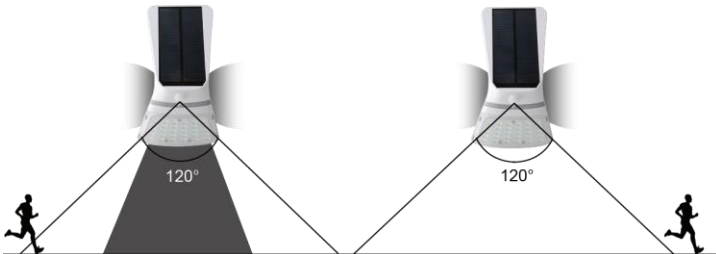

## Working Modes
